Fitness For Everyone

3 different fitness classes are offered at NWESS. They all are geared to seniors and focus on maintaining flexibility and individual fitness levels.

YOGA - Sessions usually span 3 months at a time. Classes are once per week: Monday mornings 9:00 to 10:30 am.

Fit For Your Life - Sessions usually span 2 months at a time. Classes are twice per week: Wednesday and Friday 9:30 to 10:30 am. Classes incorporate the use of light hand weights, small fitness balls and fitness bands or tubing as well as some cardio.

**Please note: the cost for both Yoga and Fit For Your Life sessions are determined by the number of participants in each session.

**If there is room available in a session, anyone can start mid session and the cost will be prorated by the number of classes remaining in that session.

Fun & Fitness - classes are held Tuesday mornings 11:00 to 12:00. These classes are held on a drop in basis. Cost for members are \$2.00 per class.

✓ Bread or buns	X Beef jerky, cabbage rolls, perogies
✓ Cakes, squares, muffins	X Cakes or pies with cream, cheese, egg or pudding fillings
✓ Cookies	X Cream éclairs or cream puffs
✓ Fruit pies	X Dairy products such as milk, cream, yogurt, cottage cheese, or butter
✓ Jelly rolls	X Home canned/processed food items
✓ Sweet dough items like doughnuts	X Icings made with eggs or dairy products


